- How far away is the Earth from the Sun?
 The Earth is about 150 thousand / million kilometers from the Sun.
- 2 How hot is the Sun?

The temperature on the Sun is about 55 / 5500 degrees Celsius.

- What did the English scientist Isaac Newton prove?
 He proved that the planets in our solar system move around the Earth / Sun.
- How long does it take for light from the Sun to get to the Earth?
 It takes about 8 minutes / hours.
- How many planets are there in our solar system (מערכת השמש / المنظومة الشمسية)?

 Scientists aren't sure. They know that there are seven / eight planets, but there could be more.
- 6 How long would it take an airplane to reach the Sun?
 If you fly non-stop, it would take you about 20 years / days.
- When does a solar eclipse occur?
 This happens when the moon is between the Sun and the planet Venus / Earth.
- Where does the Sun rise and where does it set?
 It rises in the east / south and sets in the north / west.
- Which planet in our solar system is closest to the Sun?
 The planet Mercury / Neptune is closest to the Sun.
- How much bigger is the Sun than the Earth?
 The Sun is about 110 / 1100 times bigger than the Earth.
